Promoting Subjects: Sociology Department, University of Bologna (Italy). The Master is managed by Italian NgO CESTAS (Centre of Health Education and Appropriate Health Technologies) with the financial support of the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs – General Directorate for Development Cooperation.

Beneficiary Subjects: Local Planning Authorities, Universities, Institutes of Research, Non-Governmental Development Organizations.

Admission: University Degree.

Scholarships cover the following costs: University fees, board and lodging, one year return ticket, insurance.

Candidates have to certify a good knowledge of Italian language; competences in Italian language will be evaluated by an on-line test and an oral exam via video-conference. CESTAS will organize a course of Italian Language in e-learning at beginning of Master

Location: Bologna (Italy)

Didactic program:

The first three months of the didactic program will be held in e-learning. The second part of the didactic program will be held in Italy (in Bologna), starting from March 2010.

Candidates must to guarantee the availability of a personal computer with an Internet connection; headphones and a Webcam.

The Master program is a full time course and consists of 450 hours of lectures and 300 hours of Internship. Attendance to lectures is compulsory. Only 20% of absence is permitted.
